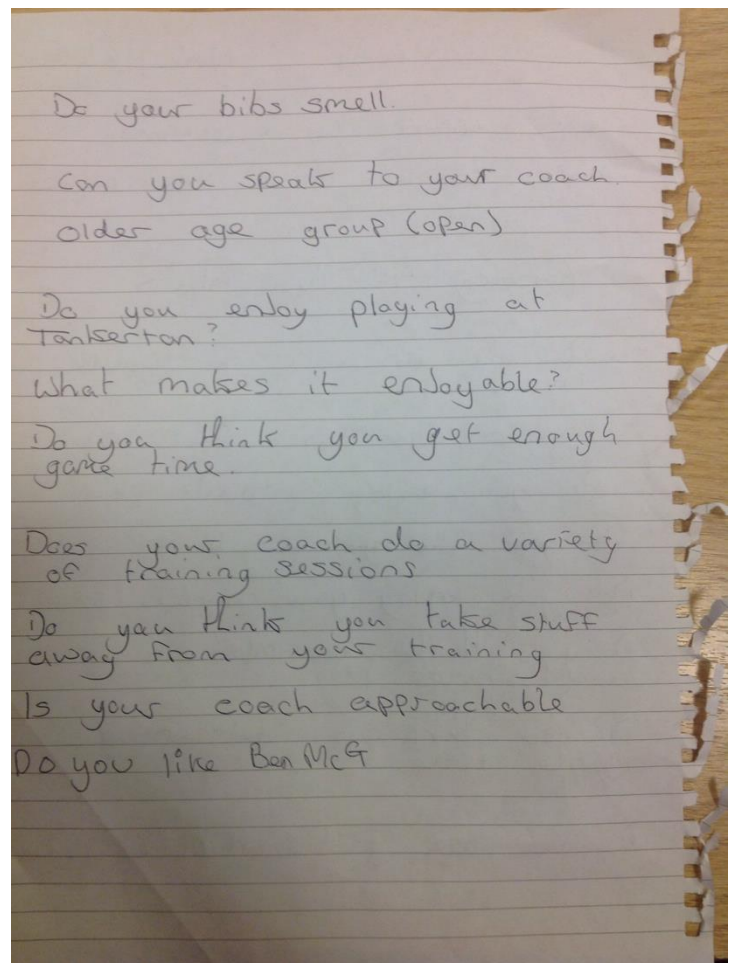
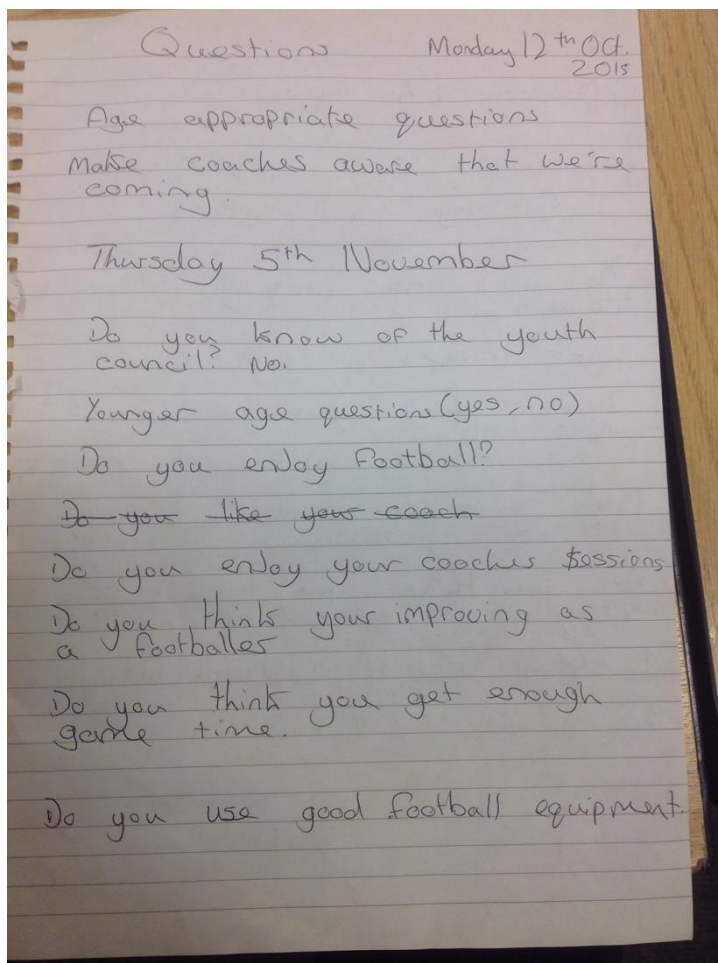
Starter Activity
